

Supplemental Rules
Adopted August 6, 2007

Architectural Review and Approval Except for the initial construction of residential dwellings and related structures, no improvement or structure of any kind, including without limitation, any building, fence, wall, screen enclosure, satellite dish, landscape device, driveway, or other improvement shall be commenced, erected, placed or maintained upon any lot, nor shall any addition, change or alteration therein be made, unless and until the plans, specifications shall be evaluated as to the harmony of exterior design and location in relation to surrounding structures. Each owner will submit an Architectural Review Board form. The request must include a copy of the property survey showing the location of the modification and the type of material being used.
